TRAVEL: There are basically two options for flights to Vermont.

1. Fly to Burlington, VT (a 45 minute drive to Stowe) approx **\$450 round trip** per person.
2. Fly to Manchester, NH (a 2 ½ hour drive to Stowe) Southwest “Wanna Get Away” fares from **\$177 - \$255 round trip** per person - significant savings if you’re okay with the drive.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION: Members would be on their own to find best/preferred rental car rates. Consider coordinating flights and sharing the cost of rental.

Stowe Mt Road Shuttle is free and runs all day long between Stowe village and the mountain.

LODGING: Four nights Ski in-Ski out lodging at Stowe Mountain Lodge from around **\$500 for four nights** (twin share). Several other accommodation nearby & less expensive (**\$377 for four nights** at Commodores Inn was the least expensive I found).

LIFT TICKETS: Depending when and how you buy, one-day tickets can **range from \$72 - \$108**.

BOTTOM LINE: The cost of this trip depends on where you fly in and where you stay, ranging from **\$840** (cheaper flight, lodging, tickets) **through \$1,300** (higher cost flight, lodging, tickets).
